

Oona Airola (Born in 1988) is a Finnish actress and singer. She has a Master of Arts degree in acting from the Theatre Academy of Helsinki, graduated in 2015. She works as a freelancer in Helsinki. She became known from Juho Kuosmanen's feature film "The happiest day in the life of Olli Mäki", which was awarded with the Un certain regard-prize in Cannes film festival in 2016. She had been acting earlier in theatre and in few short films. After opening filmrole as Raija Mäki in Kuosmanen's film, she has been mostly acting on films, and on music. She is known also as a singer, for example in a collective called "Ykspihlajan Kino-orkesteri" which has been mostly working on filmcomposing as well. Oona Airola also writes music to an orchestra "Lada Nuevo". Oona Airola was born in the middle of Finland, west coast, in a small city called Kokkola. She is third sibling of five children. Her main passion beside music and acting has always been horses, and on her own words, she basically grew up on horseback.
